

# **Management Policy Students Extreme Weather**

#### VISION

The comfort and safety of all students is maintained during play periods affected by extreme weather.

#### **ACTION**

## Extreme Weather – to come in early from yard play

- Senior Staff will determine extreme weather (heat/rain/wind etc)
- 2 blasts of the siren during Recess or Lunchtime will indicate extreme weather supervision is to come into effect.
- ❖ All students to return to class areas. <u>No student to remain outside.</u>
- ❖ Non-class based staff supervise single teaching areas and double teaching areas will release and supervise each other's classes.
- ❖ A single siren indicates the end of the extreme weather restrictions.

#### Extreme Weather – to remain inside instead of outside for yard play

- ❖ The Senior Staff will determine extreme weather procedures.
- Temperatures of 35°C or more will necessitate the instigation of the extreme weather policy.
- ❖ Temperatures will be verified by 10.55 am and 12.50 pm by Internet or phone calls to the Weather Bureau.
- 2 blasts of the siren at the commencement of Recess and Lunchtime will indicate extreme weather supervision to come into effect.
- ❖ All students to remain inside unless going to the Canteen with a school approved 'Sunsafe hat'. Students return to class ASAP.
- ❖ Non-class based staff supervise single teaching areas and double teaching areas will release and supervise each other's classes.

### **REVIEW**

Staff and parents will contribute feedback regarding the effectiveness of this policy as the need arises. All stakeholders will be consulted.

(Both the 35 degrees temperature and that students remain inside was reviewed and passed in Term 1 2004 by both staff and Governing Council)
