No Vaping/Smoking Updated Signage

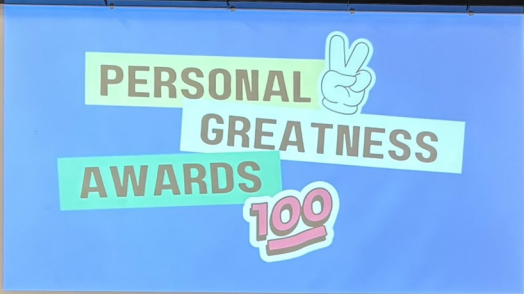

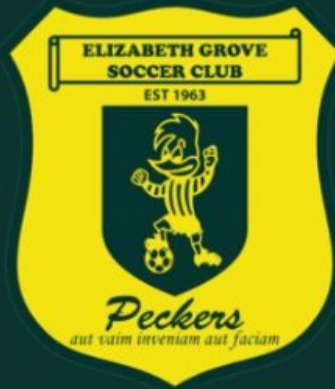

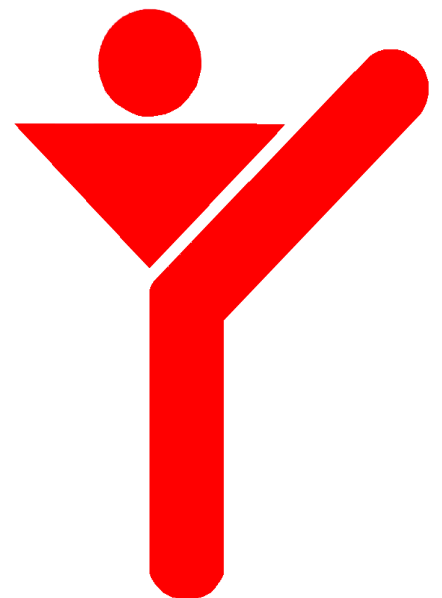
