We have certainly experienced the cold and wet conditions that winter brings through our July holidays! I do hope that families had the opportunity to relax and enjoy time together with their children as we begin the second half of the year. It is timely to remind families of a few things as we move in to Term 3. These include:

- Daily attendance and arrival at school by 8:50am each day is essential in supporting students with their learning. It is expected that a reason is provided for each day's absence.
- All students are expected to comply with the school's dress code – please purchase clothing that meets the code, which does not include hoodies. The front office has a range of clothing sizes and options to purchase.
- If there are concerns to do with your child please make a time that suits both you and the teacher to meet to discuss these. It is difficult for the teacher to meet when students are entering the class at 8:50am or immediately after school at 3pm so please make a mutually agreed time.
- Please avoid gathering with other parents near classrooms at the end of the day as this is very disruptive to teachers who need to give important information to students as they finish the day's learning. Please wait until the classroom door is open or you are invited in to the class before entering the room. Parents are asked to wait outside of school grounds until a few minutes before the bell, especially if they wish to socialise with other parents.
- Please note that our school policy allows students to bring a mobile phone to school but it must be turned off while at school.

Learning Centre Toilet Renovations

Work has begun on renovations to the Learning Centre toilets and this will cause some changes to our normal procedures for student use of toilets during play and learning times. Teachers have provided information to students about these changes, which include:

During learning time – R-4 students will use the junior primary toilets near Room 12, Year 5s will use the outside gym toilet and the Year 6/7s will use the quad toilets.

During play time – R-2 students will use the junior primary toilets and Year 3-7 students will use the quad toilets.

New Student Services to be constructed

The school is finalising plans for the building of a new Student Services area and it is hoped that construction will begin later this year. Our current space is too small to undertake the growing use of Student Services. Essentially it will see a new area adjacent to the front office connected by a new corridor and will use the unused 'urinal' space in the junior primary boy's toilet. Once the plans are finalised they will be displayed for your perusal in the front office.

Oral Medication Management Changes

Families of students who take prescribed oral medication during the school day will receive information about changes to school procedures in Week 1, Term 3. In brief all oral medication (such as tablets) will be collected from classes and be administered from Student Services during recess or lunch. This change is being implemented as the Education Department introduce new guidelines for the administration of medication in schools.

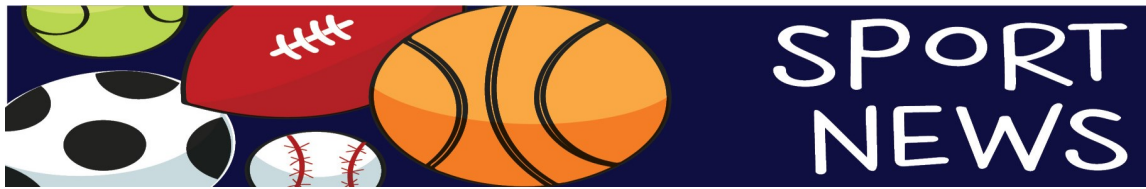

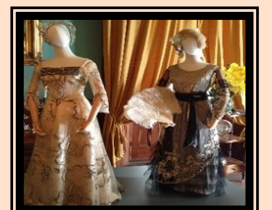
Elizabeth Rise Community Centre – New timetable on PCW notice board. There are four new group activities added this term.
