PRESCHOOL CAR PARK

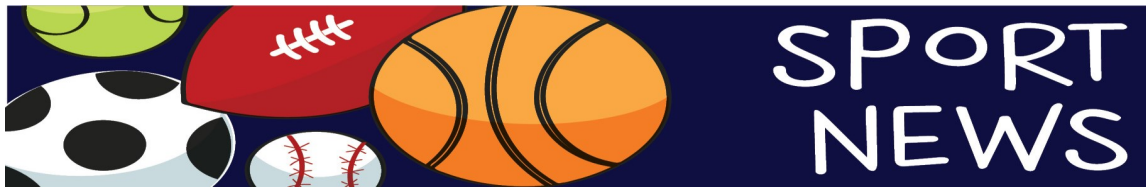

Have you returned your 2018 School Card application? We still have many families who were School Card approved last year but have not applied this year. A new form needs to be filled out EVERY year!

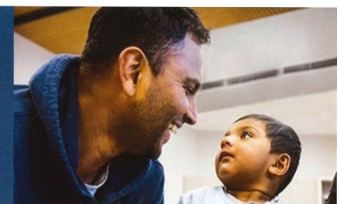
