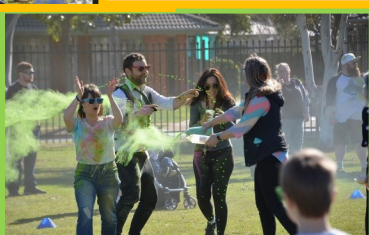


On the colour run everyone was exhilarated with running and getting colour on them. The best thing about it was getting colour everywhere and running around.

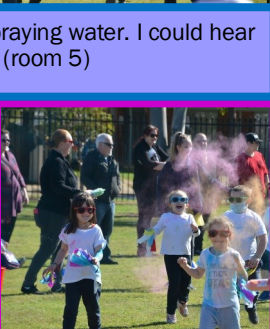
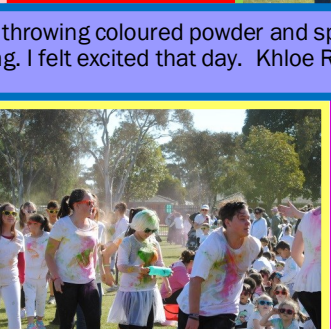
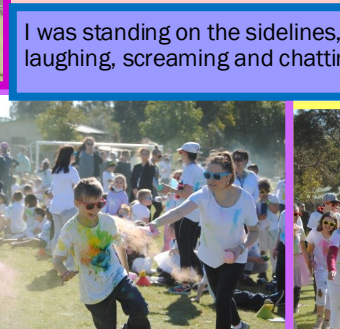


My eyes opened to a variety of different coloured powders flying in every direction staining my white t-shirt. It was extreme fun and a great way to end the day.
